Beginning Sunday, June 20, we will allow a limited number of people to attend worship in the sanctuary. This marks the start of dual platform worship. Click the button for more information.

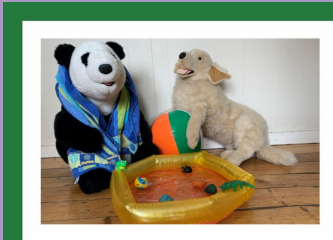
