Old Business:

- 1. Financial Report All our budget lines are looking good
- 2. Elevator issue Pete will call Bruce Casler for update on replacement lights for panels; will raise issue of overhead lights staying on all the time.
- 3. AFE Wildlife Nuisance Control began work on our bat problem on October 6.
- 4. Bobbi ordered shades from North Country Window fashions; installation in early November is on schedule.
- 5. Finish painting side entrance staircase up to 2nd floor room (Stefan to secure little giant ladder for job).
- 6. Delay application of another round of Roundup until spring (Pete)
- 7. Look into handicapped sized toilet for side entrance bathroom (Stefan)
- 8. Pete spoke with Tyler Locke re: need a contract for snow removal, lawn mowing, and leaf removal for the 2016-17 year. Contract emailed on 10/5/16.
- 9. Agreed to accept bid from TTS to remove cherry tree from Memorial Garden and cedar trees. Pete will follow-up with TTS and Ryan tree services. Memorial Committee has agreed to pay the entire bill of \$500.00
- 10. Bobbi inspected fire extinguishers
- 11. Request to install dead bolt locks on bathroom doors that indicate if bathroom is occupied or vacant (Stefan)
- 12. Upper sash of one of the bell tower windows in bowing. Bobbi will contact Kingsley to see if he can make repairs.
- 13. Request from library committee to install a security cable that will secure their laptop computer. They have provided the cable. Phil will install.
- 14. Check leaky pressure tank fitting in basement bathroom toilet. Stefan adjusted the linkage and toilet flushes fine. There still is a small leak and inside parts should be replaced to conserve water.
- 15. Begin readying building and grounds for winter
 - a. Drain and store garden hoses (Erik)
 - b. Turn off valves in basement to outside faucets (Erik)
 - c. Make sure all windows are closed and locked (Delay given warm weather)
 - d. Install rigid insulation board in doorway to bell tower room (do this in November so James can remove Joel's books for delivery to Rochester in late October); Discussion re: options to allow church bell to be rung year round cut hole in bell tower room floor so rope can extend into James' office. (Stefan and Erik)
 - e. Swap out screens for storms in James' office and the kitchen (Phil)
 - f. Empty and unplug dehumidifiers
 - g. Change furnace filters (Phil)
 - h. Schedule Grant's to check heating systems (Pete)

- 16. EAC committee to meet with B&G at our November or December meetings to discuss projects of mutual interest.
- 17. Bobbi has contacted Coakely's to fix areas in sanctuary where carpet is separating from vinyl border
