Did you know...

That if global emissions of greenhouse gases continue at their present rate of growth, the average global temperature in 2100 is expected to be 4.5 degrees Celsius (8 deg F) warmer than in 1900? This far exceeds the current goal of limiting climate changes to 2 degrees Celsius.
